ORAL MEDICINE & RADIOLOGY

- Able to identify potentially malignant disorders of the oral cavity and refer to the concerned specialty for their management.
- Should have an adequate knowledge about routine laboratory investigations and Interpretation of their results.

- Be aware of the significance of intra- and extra-oral radiographs in forensic identification and age estimation.
- Should be familiar with jurisprudence, ethics and understand the significance of dental records with respect to law
- Able to identify the pathogenic affecting oral cavity, head & neck region.

CONSERVATIVE DENTISTRY AND ENDODONTICS

- To be able to perform preventive modalities like a traumatic restorative treatment, fluoride varnishes, sealants, and preventive resin restorations to prevent dental caries and promote oral health.
- Exhibit competency in performing and restoring Class I and Class II cavities using amalgam.
- Skillfully restore Class V and Class I cavities with Glass Ionomer Cement (GIC).
- Display the ability to diagnose and provide appropriate treatment for pulpal involvement in teeth, including pulp capping procedures.
