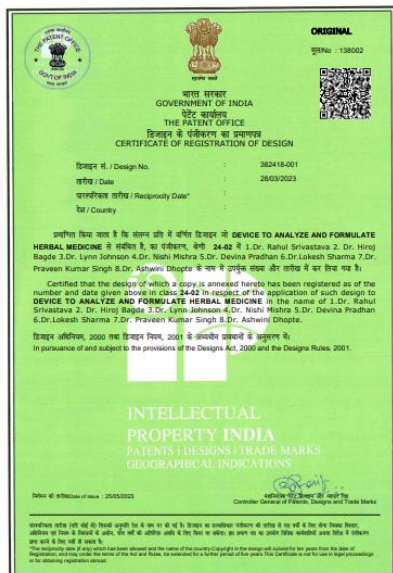

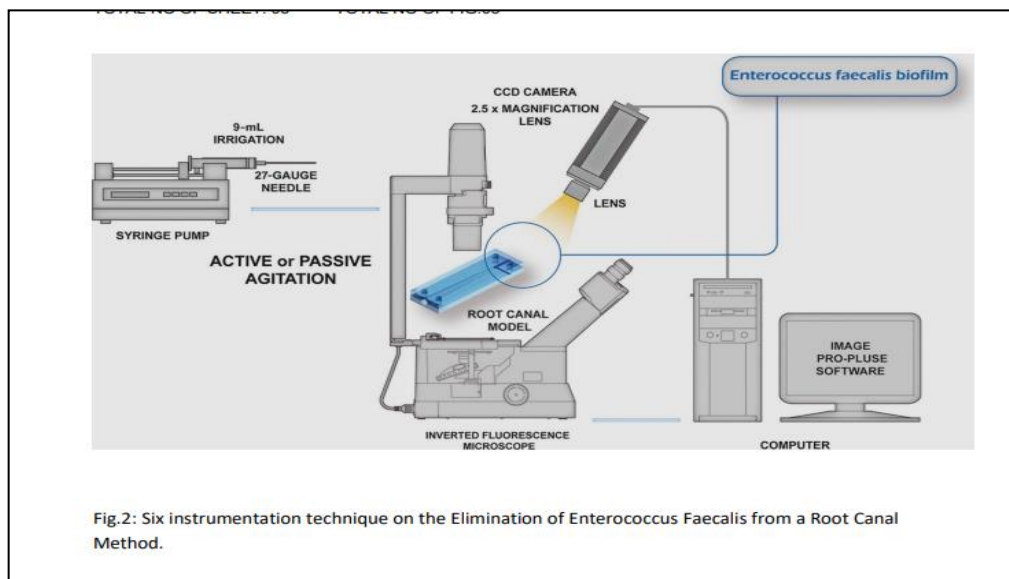


Fig.2: Six instrumentation technique on the Elimination of Enterococcus Faecalis from a Root Canal Method.

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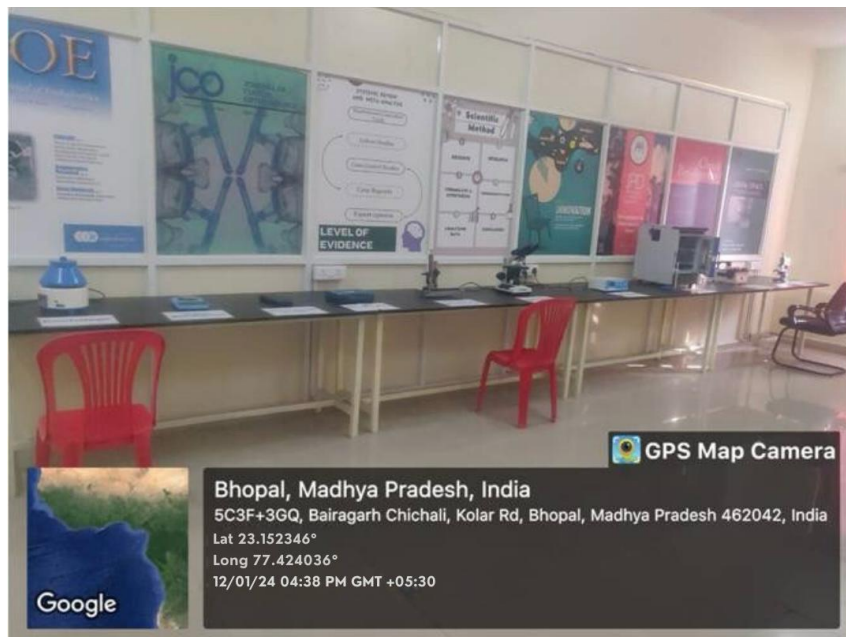
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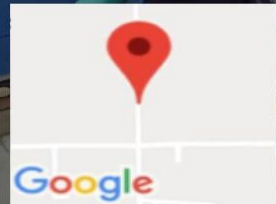


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
